The fuel injector inlet screen installed as original equipment in the subject aircraft is difficult to remove and install during routine inspection.

A fuel injector inlet screen replacement kit, part number 756 782, consisting of two fuel inlet fittings, two strainer assemblies and two plugs, which will facilitate removal and installation, is now available and shall be installed at or before the next 100 hour inspection in accordance with the sketch on the reverse side of this letter.

The fuel injector inlet screen replacement kit, part number 756 782, will be provided by automatic factory distribution. It will not be necessary for you to submit your purchase orders for your requirements. Credit will be issued for kit, part number 756 782, upon receipt of a warranty and credit claim form and the old fuel injector inlet screen. Since the removal of the screen is routine at the 100 hour inspection, no warranty labor will be allowed.
